One in four older homes need to update their fire safety equipment. How old are your smoke and CO alarms?

Replace smoke alarms every 10 years. Replace CO alarms every 7-10 years, based on model. Consider purchasing an alarm with a sealed lithium battery. It provides hassle-free protection for 10 years. No need to change a battery!

75% of homeowners don't know where to install smoke alarms. Do you have enough?

Place smoke alarms on every floor and inside/outside of all bedrooms. Place a CO alarm near sleeping areas and on each floor.

Do your alarms incorporate the newest features?

- Sealed-in lithium battery
- Digital display
- Intelligent multi-sensor

Do you need other safety products?

- Fire extinguisher
- Escape ladder
- Mold and Radon kit
